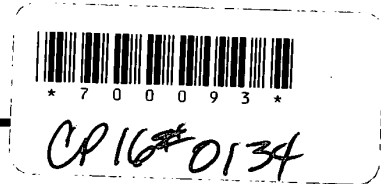

Clark County Citizens United, Inc. has decided to add Hillsboro Ho soil to our maps according to information received by one of our Board members who is familiar with that soil. Even though it is soil that is predominately in drainage areas which lends it to those kinds of problems, the growing capacity of the soil is still good. As we add that information, we see that most of that soil is in addition and adjacent to the Hi series and is located in the urban areas of the county. There is a few small islands, otherwise, and the parcel mentioned has a very small portion of Ho soil.
