Hello Susan. The process is this. When testimony, comments, emails, letters, or any Comp Plan related documents that are generated internally or externally, are received for the Index record, they are forwarded to my inbox for recording. Once I have input the information into the database, they are sent to our records department to be scanned for permanent electronic access, then are returned to me to be filed and kept in our department for reference.

Most everything that we've received has been entered into the database through the end of March. With the exception of the open house materials from the 25th along with comments received outside the open houses. I am preparing to continue indexing today and I have all those materials here. A binder was prepared for the Board for the hearing on April 14th that includes comments from the 8 open houses. We also have a copy of that in our department. If there are things submitted directly to the 6th Floor that they have not forwarded to us, then obviously we wouldn't have them.

We can make the index record available for your perusal in our department if you want to make an appointment to come in and look through it.

County sets open houses to expand scope of growth plan study

Vancouver, WA – The Board of County Councilors has added a fourth alternative for consideration in the environmental review needed to update the local Comprehensive Growth Management Plan.

Three alternatives were approved for environmental review in the fall of 2014:

- No change.

- Changes to long-range planning for some rural and urban areas.
- Urban growth boundary changes for smaller cities.

The new alternative, approved for study on March 11, considers changes to land use plans in rural areas. Information about all the alternatives will be presented at two open houses, both 5:30-7 p.m.:

- **March 25:** Ridgefield High School, 2724 South Hillhurst Road
- **April 1:** Hockinson High School, 16819 NE 159th St.

The Board will hold a public hearing at 10 a.m. April 14 at the Public Service Center, 1300 Franklin St.
