Tim, I've been here 50 years now. The first well I drilled was on the north parcel, which put out 5 GPM. That was in 1965. Then, virtually all the lots surrounding me were divided into 5 acre lots and that north well dried up. I had it fracked but it didn't come back. I had bought the parcel to the south by then, so I had to trench the length of the property, almost 1/2 mile, to supply water to the north end. Then I bought some more land and got two more wells, neither of which is ample enough to support my farming. My daughter put a well in in the center of the property, but that water is deeper, and not at all similar to my well, rated at 5 GPM, but it supplies 4 houses here and my irrigation. Not a pretty picture. I'm sure the same pattern will follow to others who are close to increased development. The well logs can prove that. v
