

County plans meetings to introduce revamped Comp. Plan alternative

Officials will hold three public meetings next week to provide information and gather feedback on a newly-revised version of the controversial Alternative 4 plan to alter the county's Comprehensive Growth Management Plan

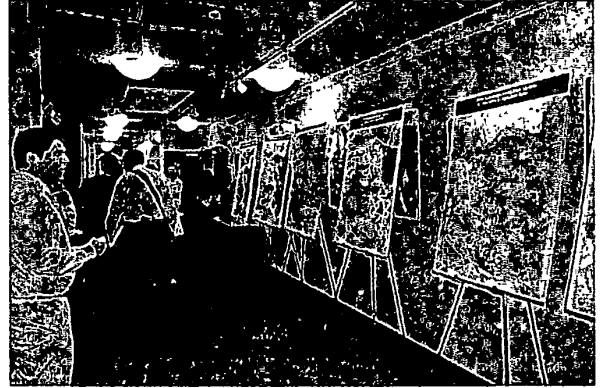
Alternative 4 has faced some intense scrutiny before, but recent changes first proposed by Clark County Councilor David Madore require a fresh look before the update process can continue

The first meeting will be held from 5:30 p.m. to 7 p.m. Monday, Nov. 16 at Hockinson High School, 16819 NE 159th St.

The second will be held the following evening from 5:30 p.m. to 7 p.m. Tue., Nov. 17, at Ridgefield High School, 2630 S. Hillhurst Road

At a third meeting, the Clark County Planning Commission will hold a public hearing at 6:30 p.m. Thurs., Nov. 19 on the sixth floor of the Public Service Center, 1300 Franklin St. in Vancouver, to receive comments and develop an updated recommendation to send the Board of County Councilors
