My top priorities are

- 1 Conversion of most Agricultural zoning to Rural
- 2 Minimum Rural parcel size of 2 acres except in cluster subdivisions
- 3 No Rural zone requiring parcel size greater than 5 acres
4. Remove all parcels from 80-acre Forest zone that are not owned by industrial forest companies
- 5 Reduce 40-acre Forest zoning to 5 or 10 acres
6. Allow cluster subdivisions in 5 or 10 acre Forest zoning and in any remaining Ag zoning
7. Allow segregation, rather than subdivision, of land where all parcels created are at least 5 acres (same as it was prior to 1993)
