Oliver,

In response to the message that Thorpe was not able to open some of the files, this may explain why:

They should have no problem opening the docx Word documents and xlsx Excel documents since those are standard Microsoft programs that they use routinely.

The other files are FoxPro files included as proof of process. I included them, not because Thorpe will need them, but because they provide the original source database and programs that operate on the database files.

The .dbf files are FoxPro database files and the .cdx are the FoxPro indexes for those database files. The .prg files are the FoxPro program source files and the .fxp are the Foxpro compiled version of those files.

Thorpe should not need any of the FoxPro files because all of the FoxPro database files have been exported to Excel files that have been included.

The FoxPro program files are text readable files that have been copied into the Word documents. Since FoxPro is so intuitive, the operations should be understandable to show how the original database yielded the totals used in the Word documents.
