Planning staff doing exactly the opposite as directed

County Councilors learned today in a work session on the county's 20-year Land Use Plan that the clear direction given by the Board on July 15, 2015, was ignored

Do not include anything in the Comp Plan that is not required by the state Do not embed any unnecessary social engineering policies in the Comp Plan In particular, do not include the Growing Healthier Report and do not include the Aging Readiness Plan

After that clear direction 9 months ago, the planning staff revealed that they've continued to push their social engineering policies as evidenced by today's presentation that dedicated 3 slides to specifically include those rejected documents by name under the headlines of "What's New"

When challenged today about doing the opposite of the Board's direction, the planning director argued that they were not directed to remove those social engineering documents.

The slides also claim that the documents were officially added to the Comp Plan in 2012 So far, it appears that the minutes of the 2012 meetings do not support that claim

Once again, the citizens are shown that the Planning staff continues to push a version of the Comp Plan upon the people in contradiction to the clear directions given by the Citizen Representatives - their County Councilors

The Planning Director and 2 Prosecuting Attorneys are already being investigated for allegedly making other false and misleading statements to the citizens and their public servants on the Comp Plan - a gross misdemeanor under RCW 9A 76 175.

"A person who knowingly makes a false or misleading material statement to a public servant is guilty of a gross misdemeanor "Material statement" means a written or oral statement reasonably likely to be relied upon by a public servant in the discharge of his or her official powers or duties" [http://app.leg.wa.gov/rcw/default.aspx?cite=9A 76 175](http://app.leg.wa.gov/rcw/default.aspx?cite=9A%2076%20175)
