Dear Councilors,

The GMA directs counties to use reasonable measures to inform the public whenever, changes are made to the Comprehensive Plan. Clark County Citizens United, Inc. has been given only a small part of that process. Even though the landowners, whom CCCU represents, appealed to the HB and two different courts to have their voices heard, it has been disregarded. CCCU came in 2003 for the 2004 update, because a mystery donor sent CCCU the SEIS. When CCCU responded to that document, they were told not to get involved because the county was only working on the urban areas, and would get to the rural lands, later. Three of CCCU Board members, as well as Oliver Orjiako, remember that directive. The Planning Commission was also told the same thing. CCCU, Inc. came forward at a work session in 2013, because there was a change in commissioners and CCCU wanted to understand their position. At the time, a small notice was displayed in the newspaper saying work was going to begin on the Comprehensive Plan 2016 update. CCCU has received very little information from the county, throughout the GMA process, even though we should have been the primary stakeholders, via the courts. The 2016 Comprehensive Plan update, must reflect the law, as it was directed by the Superior Court in 1997 and the Court of Appeals Division II, in 1999.
