Clark County 20-Year Comprehensive Management Plan Review 2015-2035



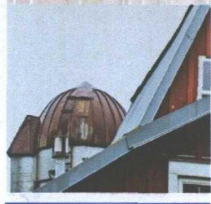
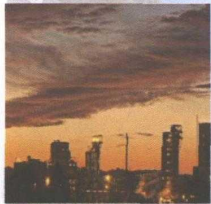

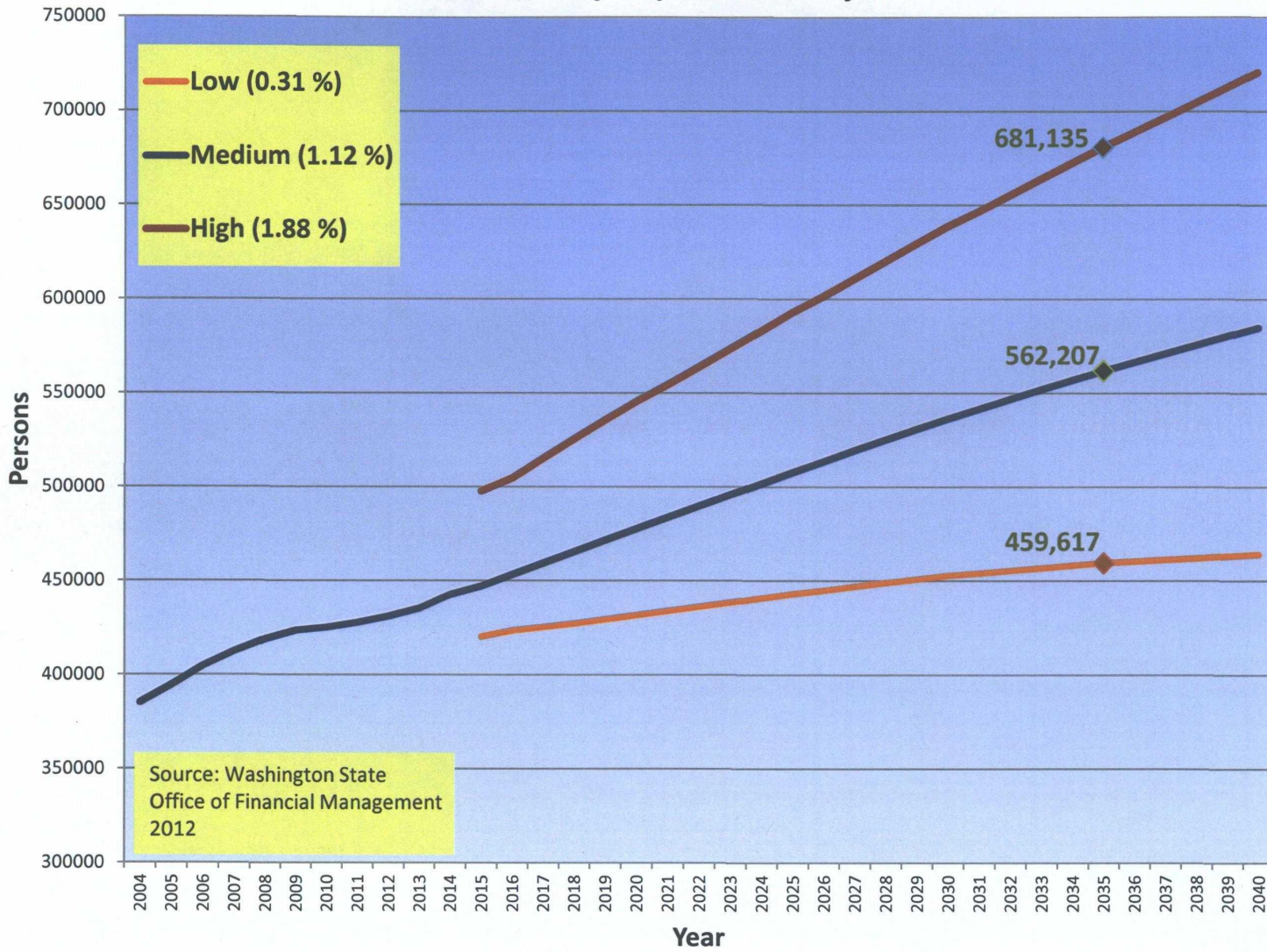

Clark County Population Projections

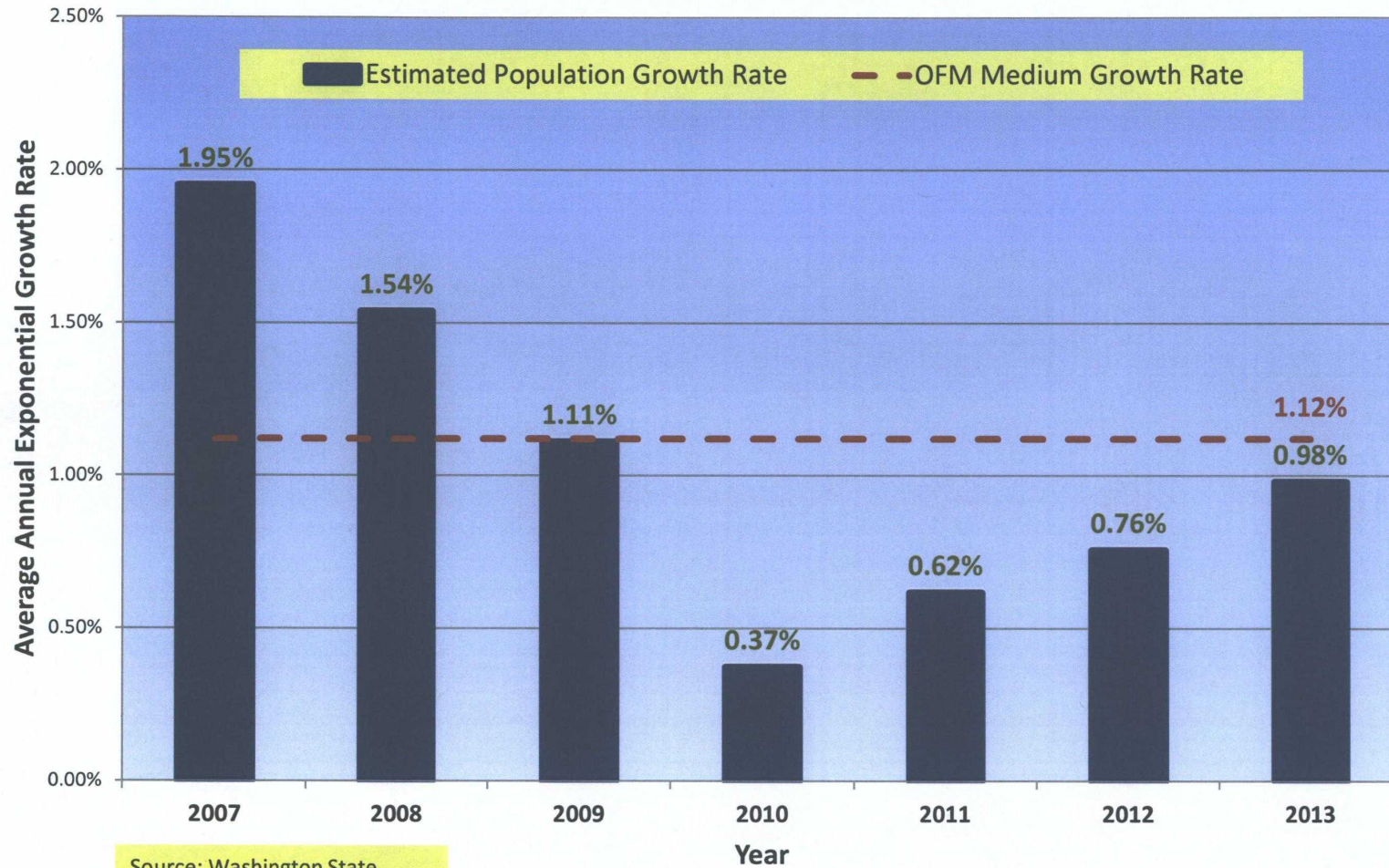

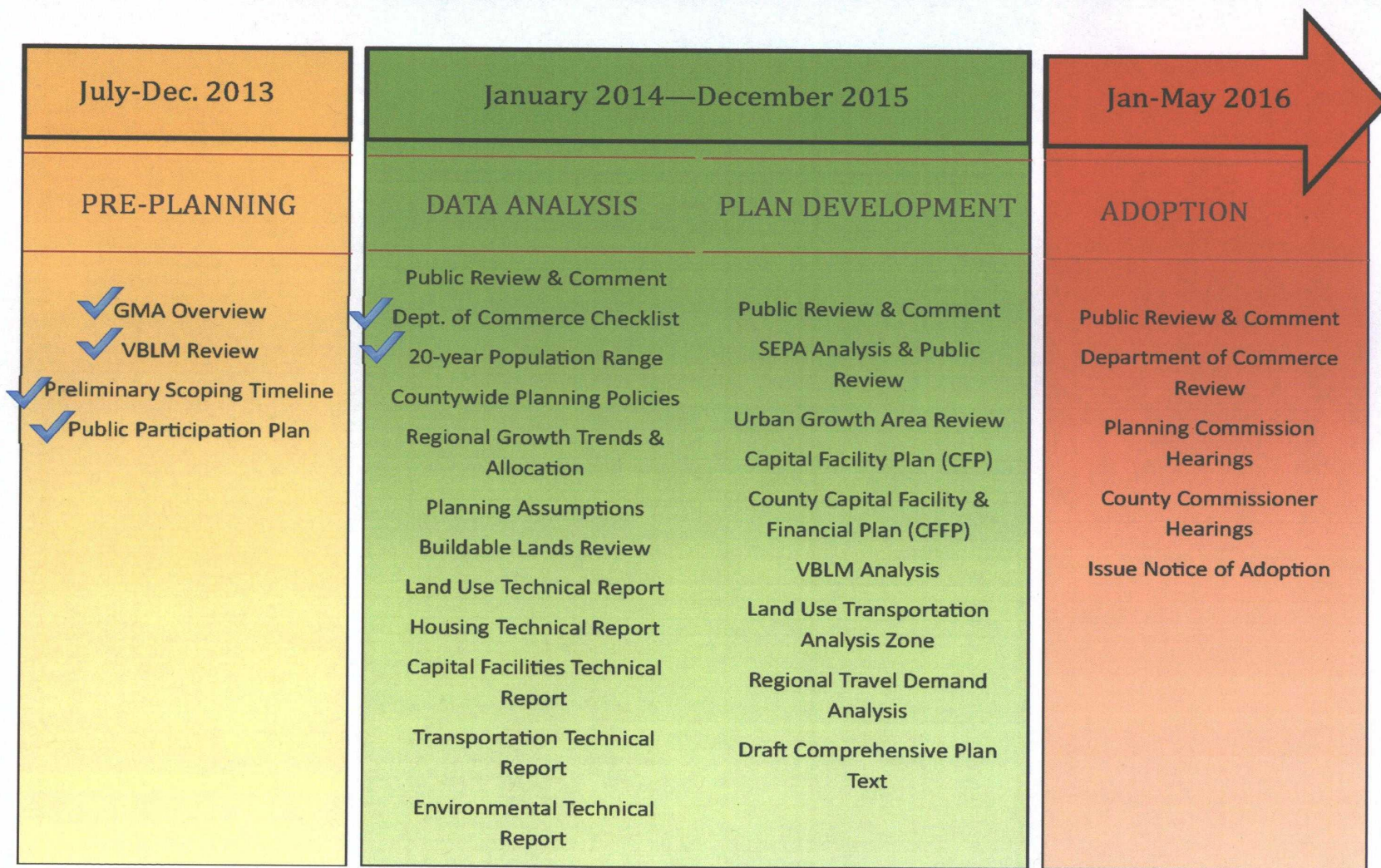

- **Receive e-mail notifications.** Sign up to receive automatic e-mail notifications on any upcoming meetings and information related to the project.
- **Attend meetings.** Throughout the update process, meetings - such as workshops, open houses and Planning Commission and Board of County Commissioner hearings - will be opportunities for public comment and participation. The meetings will provide information about the project status and in what direction it is headed. Your attendance can directly impact the decision-making process. Meetings involving the 2016 update are kept up-to-date in the 'Meetings' page and will also be posted on the 2016 Comprehensive Plan update home page.
- **Written testimony.** Letters and e-mails are always welcome. 2016 Comprehensive Growth Management Plan update

Clark County is updating its Comprehensive Plan. The current plan, adopted in 2007, covers 2007 to 2024. The update will extend the current plan's growth outlook from 2015 to 2035. We expect to complete the update project in June 2016.

Updates will refresh policies and elements of the plan with an eye toward population and employment growth over the next 20 years. With this growth comes potential for increased demand for residential, commercial and industrial land, parks, schools, services, utility facilities and roads. The 2016 update focuses on future land use needs in unincorporated urban areas, but has links to planning in cities, rural areas and the Town of Yacolt.

Public input is a major part of the 2016 update. This website is designed to encourage and facilitate public involvement. We will keep the information on this site current, and hope you will use it to comment on parts of the plan that might change.

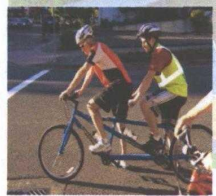
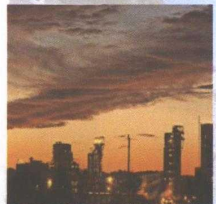
