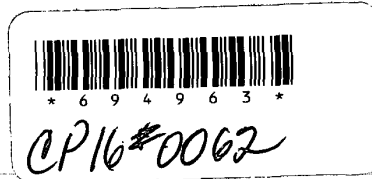

Re: Clark County School District Capital Facility Plans

Dear Oliver:

This letter is being sent on behalf of the Battle Ground, Camas, Evergreen, Green Mountain, Hockinson, LaCenter, Ridgefield, Vancouver and Washougal School Districts (Clark County School Districts) to request temporary suspension or waiver of the requirement to submit updates to the School District Capital Facility Plans (CFPs) every four years.

The last time the County adopted the Clark County School District CFPs was in 2011. If updates to the CFPs are adopted in 2015 to satisfy the four year requirement, the CFPs will not include or address decisions that are made as part of the 2016 Comprehensive Growth Management Plan update. We would prefer to submit updated CFPs in early 2016 for inclusion and adopting as part of the County's 2016 update. The later submission will assist the County with its obligations under the Growth Management Act.

Thank you for considering this request and for your ongoing efforts to address schools in the long range planning work you do. Let me know if you need anything else from me.
