CCCU continues our research over the Comp Plan, and it certainly is interesting reading. We were so focused on the Agri-Forest lands in 1994, that we failed to really see the travesty that was happening all over rural Clark County. But, we could only have so many items on our list, as we went to court. We have also applied our parcel size requests to the outlined sections on our large maps, along with matching them with the soils map and the non-conforming parcel status. It is amazing how CCCU's recommendations fit like a glove to the parcels. In the process many new resource parcels were created, even as we eliminated those that were not appropriate. That information, plus the readings, so clearly demonstrate the personal agenda that took place, and continues to take place in rural land use planning. We will submit that research information into the record, after it is placed in our data base and printed for submission.

I also reviewed our membership and those who donated money to our cases. It is a very large black binder of hundreds of landowners who put their trust in Clark County Citizens United, Inc., a group they knew nothing about, but desperately hoped would be able to help them. Our work isn't done, yet.
