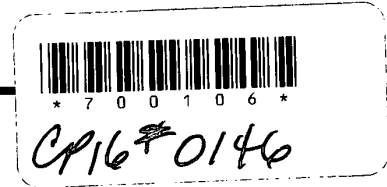

Hello Eric:

Thank you for your email this morning. We recognize that the vbml underestimates capacity. If we return to true capacity we may have to ask the Board to change the population target. We are not asking the cities to consider reduction in UGA boundary. If the cities need more time I can understand but this is the result of us all asking the Board to choose the OFM medium number which is smaller than the 2007 growth target. We can ask the Board to keep the 2007 population number but move the planning horizon to 2035. Something to consider. It may or may not require planning for more jobs in terms of 1 jobs per household. Thanks.
