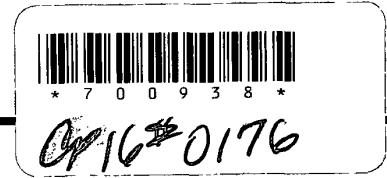

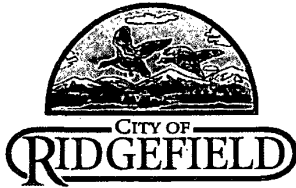

*Re: Comprehensive Plan – 2016 Urban Growth Area Changes*


Dear Commissioners:

In response to County staff's request for notification of preliminary Urban Growth Area (UGA) changes as part of the 2016 Comprehensive Plan Update, the City of Ridgefield is not currently proposing any UGA changes or expansions as part of this update cycle.

The City reiterates its commitment to maintain the current UGA, which the City and County committed to in the 2007 comprehensive plan update cycle. Ridgefield has planned for a 2024 population of 24,706, and remains on track for that level of growth. We are seeking a population allocation that accommodates a similar growth pattern, after factoring in existing population, continued population growth, and market factor adjustments. We appreciate the BOCC's indication at the June 24, 2014 hearing that they will not seek to reduce any cities' UGA, and ask for your continued support for a revised 2035 population allocation that maintains the current UGA and population levels.

Thank you for this opportunity to comment.
