Subject: CCCU Meetings with County Staff (2016 Comp Plan Update) - Public participation

Hello Mary Beth:

Just FYI. Please, for comp plan index.

In addition to numerous public comments during Clark County Board of Commissioners hearings and materials submitted into the record, county staff met with representatives of CCCU on May 5, 2014 with Commissioner Madore at Jerry Olson's office for over 2 hours discussing the 1994 rural and resource land use zoning and related issues raised by CCCU.

On July 24, 2014, county staff met with (Carol Levanen and Susan Rasmussen) representatives of CCCU and discussed rural land use issues and home business ordinance. The meeting was titled "Home Business/Property Questions" and was attended by two Clark County Community Development staff.

On July 16, 2014 the Board of County Commissioners held a work session on SEPA Process, Rural Lands Review update, and on other issues devoted to response to inquiries regarding the designation of resource land. Please refer to the materials presented and submitted into the record including memo summarizing background of resource land designation provided to BOCC.

In August of 2014, representatives of CCCU attended all the four open houses (August 19, Vancouver Library, August 20, Lacamas Lake Lodge, August 27, Ridgefield Community Center, and August 28, Battle Ground Community Center) on Scoping Notice and provided input.

On September 11, 2014, planning staff and county GIS Staff met with CCCU representatives for over 2 hours. Discussion items include soils map sources, agricultural viability in Clark County, and 9 point requests/asks for the county to do.
