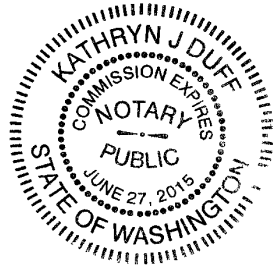

Clark County, Washington is updating its 2007 Comprehensive Growth Management Plan. As part of the process, the county is preparing a supplemental environmental impact statement (SEIS) in compliance with the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA). The environmental review process will inform the public of the potential effects of proposed growth alternatives. Scoping meetings for the SEIS were held in August 2014. The county has identified three alternatives for discussion in the SEIS. Information about these alternatives will be presented at two public meetings:
