To Whom It May Concern:

Like most of Clark County's citizens, I'm quite certain my comments will not get much, if any, consideration from the majority of the current Council so these comments will be very brief.

I support Alternative 1 for two main reasons: 1) because it is the most affordable option and 2) because it gives us the most potential for supporting ourselves with locally grown agricultural products. I've seen no evidence that current residents want to pay more in taxes for the capital facilities that would be required with other alternatives.

Alternative 4 is the least affordable option due to the required infrastructure development and increased cost of services. It would further exacerbate the congestion problems on interstate highways as the majority of jobs are still in Portland. Apparently the focus on improving the jobs:housing balance is no longer at the top of Councilor Madore's agenda. If that is so, this is quite a setback for the future of our county.
