**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING CLARK COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Clark County Planning Commission will conduct a public hearing on THURSDAY, May 21, 2015, at 6:30 p.m., at the Clark County Public Service Center, 1300 Franklin, Vancouver, WA, to consider the following:

**SUBJECT:** Amendments to Clark County development regulations

**DESCRIPTION:** Amend Section 40.260.245.D to defer to the state noise standards when measuring noise associated with winery events. Currently, noise associated with wineries is measured using the dBC weighting system instead of the state standard which uses dBA.
