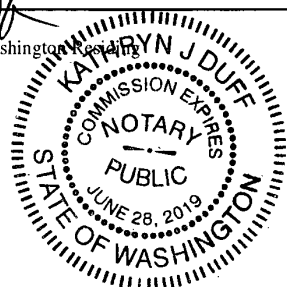

Clark County, Washington is updating its Comprehensive Growth Management Plan, to be completed by June 30, 2016. The county has prepared a draft supplemental environmental impact statement (DSEIS) in compliance with the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA), and the DSEIS will be issued on August 5, 2015. The environmental review process will inform the public of the advantages and disadvantages of proposed growth alternatives.
