We were amazed by Planning Commissioner Eileen Quiring's lack of professionalism on last Thursday's (Sept 17th) televised Planning Commission meeting. The Planning Commission members were voting on the 4 Alternatives. Ms Quiring dismissed the opponents of Alternatives 2 and 4 when she stated that the opponents consisted primarily of city dwellers who like to visit the rural areas and look at the open spaces.

My wife and I attended both meetings where public testimony was given. Most of the opponents of Alternatives 2 and 4 were either city mayors or their representatives, large land owners and farmers such as James (Jim) Wilder of Wilder Wintergreen's Christmas Tree Farm and ourselves. We own 50 acres of agriculture and timber property in Clark and Clackamas counties. We testified about the eventual loss of agriculture, timber lands and open space if large acreages are rezoned into smaller parcels. Her deliberate misrepresentation of the source of the testimonies indicate her bias on this matter.
