All:

As you know, I represent Friends of Clark County in matters relating to the current Comprehensive Plan update. I understand that there will be a joint work session of the Board of County Councilors and the Planning Commission on November 9, 2015. FOCC intends to file formal objections to this "unique" amendment to the process, objections to the fact that Councilor Madore is apparently proposing to change the previously adopted and approved planning assumptions that constitute the foundation of at least Alternatives #1-3 (and which Councilor Madore claims were used as part of his development of Alternative #4), and objections based upon violations of SEPA and public participation process of the GMA. However, members of Friends of Clark County intend on appearing at the work session and expect to have a seat at the table and to have equal time to any other organization addressing the joint session. FOCC wants to avoid this be a one-sided meeting as was the case back in January 2015 when members of CCCU were allowed to sit at the table with the BOCC, and give input, to the exclusion of all other members of the public. Unfortunately, both Ms. Reisbick and I will be out of town and unable to attend the work session. However, prior to the work session, we will designate two individuals to participate.
