Subject: Clark County 2016 Comprehensive Plan Public Record Index is flawed in its entirety - For the Public Record

Dear Councilors and Planning Commission,

On May 24, 2016 Clark County Citizens United, Inc (via Carol Levanen, Exec Secretary) submitted a testimony handout to the Planning Commission and Council, regarding a faulty Public Record Index. An example of the statement was attached. A second review of the **entire** Public Record Index of the 2016 proposed Comprehensive Plan clearly demonstrates the entire Index is flawed. There are many missing items and mis-labeling of information contained in the Index, thereby rendering it inappropriate for public record use for the purposes of appeal.

It would be very difficult to correct these flaws at this late date. The likelihood of items of testimony, important to an appeal process, being missing in the Index, is high, thereby making it useless for that purpose. A full public process would be necessary to allow for new similar testimony to be submitted.

It is unfortunate that the public cannot depend on Clark County to protect the public testimony to such a degree as to guarantee the information will be located and indexed in the Record, in such a way as to easily find it via date and title.

Clark County Citizens United, Inc asks that the 2016 Comprehensive Plan not continue processing for adoption, until such corrections occur.
