Susan and I had a meeting with TIB today on upcoming grant projects, The TIB rep believes that this WAC language applies to the incorporated cities within the Urban Growth Area as well as Clark County should the County become noncompliant with GMA by missing the June deadline

I am not a lawyer and neither is the TIB rep, but a reasonable and prudent interpretation of the WAC would lead to the conclusion that there are many other TIB funded projects within the incorporated cities in Clark County that would be in jeopardy of losing funding should the County miss the June 30 deadline

What projects are eligible for urban program funding.

Eligible projects are

- (1) Improvements on federally classified arterials,
- (2) Within a city qualifying for urban designation upon the next federal census as long as the project carries a federal arterial functional classification, or
- (3) Within the urban growth area in counties which are in full compliance with Washington state's Growth Management Act
