I just had a long discussion with Councilor Olson. She watched a good part of the June 2 Planning Commission proceedings. She believes County Council will stick with its current direction regarding AG-10 and FR-20, notwithstanding PC recommendation to the contrary. My current thought is that the County likely will need to build a record for that decision from the existing record of reports and comments and from a literature search for articles showing the economic need to support AG with a resident population (residents on the AG land); and, that small lot AG is an economically viable approach to preserving resource land, particularly in proximity to urban markets (farm to market, etc.). I do not plan to do that research but will work with Planning staff as needed.

Also, since June 21 is set for Council public hearing (and to receive testimony), it appears that there may be need for my presence on June 22nd, as well, if hearing not concluded on the 21st? Let me know if you think otherwise.
