The plan was adopted by Clark County Commissioners in November 2011 and submitted to Washington State Department of Ecology. It indicates there is enough water to serve the 2007 Comprehensive Growth Management Plan that planned for 584,310 people. The 2016 Comprehensive Growth Management Plan update is planning for 577,431.
