NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following proposal has been determined to have no probable significant adverse impact on the environment, and that an environmental impact statement is not required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c). Written comments on the following proposal, or DNS, may be submitted to the Responsible Official by **October 14, 2010**.

DESCRIPTION: The proposal is to adopt the 20 year Clark County Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan. This plan will establish policies and proposed bicycle and pedestrian projects over a twenty year period. The plan will include the following components: twenty-year priority project lists for sidewalk, bicycle lane, and off-street path improvements; recommendations for bicycle parking standards; bicycle and pedestrian policies; and a work program for the plan's implementation.

ACTION REQUESTED: It is requested that the Board of County Commissioners approve the adoption the 20-year Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan at their public hearing on November 23, 2010. The adopting ordinance will be heard by the Board at their December 14th hearing. If the plan and adopting ordinance are approved, the plan will become effective on January 1, 2011.
